Office of the Governor - Texas Travel Industry Recovery Grant Program Application Now Open!



The Office of the Governor is now accepting applications for the [Texas Travel Industry Recovery Grant Program](#) (TTIR). The purpose of this program is to provide grants to Texas businesses in the tourism, travel, and hospitality industry that were negatively impacted due to COVID-19.

The TTIR program will issue a one-time grant of up to \$20,000 to eligible Texas businesses in the following industries: arts, entertainment, and recreation; food services and drinking places; traveler accommodation; RV parks and recreational camps; traveler arrangement and reservation services; convention and tradeshow organizers; breweries; wineries; and distilleries.

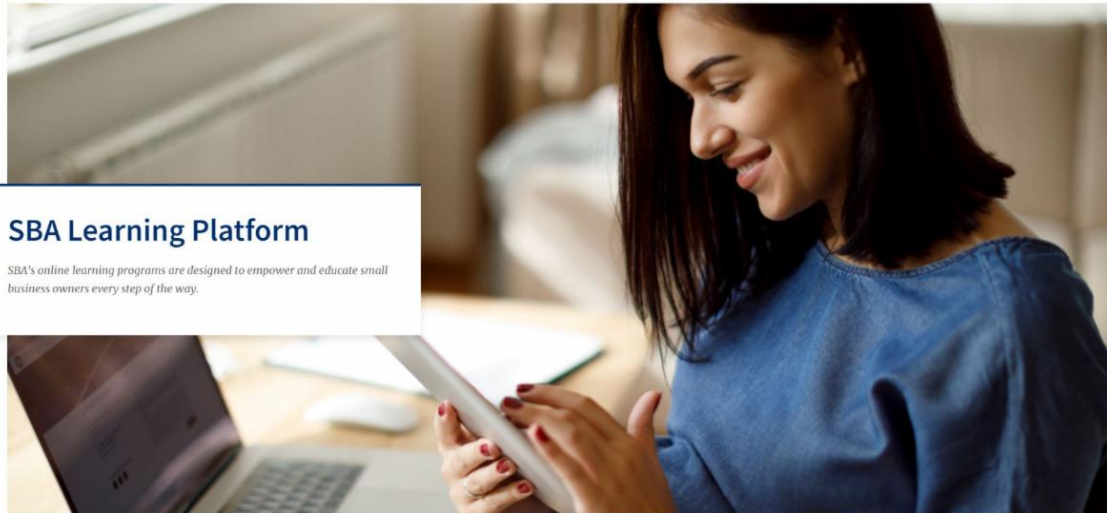

Southwest Trade Adjustment Assistance Center Match Funding Program

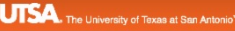
The Southwest Trade Adjustment Assistance Center (TAAC) assists U.S. manufacturing and service businesses negatively impacted by foreign trade. The Southwest TAAC helps its clients document their technical needs; then plan, implement and pay for the highest quality technical assistance available.

Criteria: Over the most current 26-month period, there must be a:

- Decline in net sales ($\geq 5\%$) from year-to-year or on an interim basis
- Decline in employment ($\geq 5\%$)
- Increase in imports of like or similar products made by your company ($\geq 5\%$)

The Southwest TAAC is funded by the U.S. Department of Commerce, Economic Development Administration.
